2. Each exhibitor or trainer must fill out and sign an official entry blank before numbers will be issued.
3. Show committee reserves the right to cancel, or combine any classes if the entries so indicate.
4. No entry fee will be returned because of withdrawal due to a scratch.
after closing of entries except where an entry, through injury or illness is unable to exhibit. In such cases, all unused entry fees will be returned upon receipt of a veterinarian or doctor's certificate.
5. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications in the current NEHC, MHC, WNE-PHA (where applicable) rule book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
6. Should any question / dispute arise it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
7. The officials listed have been invited to officiate. The show committee reserves the right to vary these names if circumstances require it.
8. A processing fee of \$25.00 will be applied to all non-negotiable checks.
9. Protective headgear must be worn at all times while mounted.
10. All dogs must be on a leash.
11. NO NUMBERS will be issued without proof of Negative Coggins and OPEN CHECK with signed entry form
12. Riders entering any Stakes class must ride in the entire division.
13. Hunter Challenge Class (class#40) must have SIX entries for payouts. Class #40 will only be run at May and September Horse Shows.

CLASS DEFINITIONS (continued)

- M. JUNIOR EQUITATION** - Open to all junior riders who are not eligible for Pre Children's or Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 3' with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional.
- N. ADULT EQUITATION** - Open to riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 2'6".
- O. LEADLINE**- Open to beginner riders age 10 and under who have never shown off the lead line before. Riders may not enter any other division. To be eligible for year-end participation ribbon, riders must compete at two shows during the season. Show secretary must submit proof of participation. Rider need not be a member to be eligible for this award.
- P. WALK TROT**- Open to riders 12 and under who have never shown at the canter. Riders may not enter any other classes
- T. HUNTER CHALLENGE**- Must have **6 entries** to run & consist of **2 parts**;
Part #1 is Class #30 - Low Hunter over Fences
Part #2 is Class # 40 - Hunter Challenge over Fences
Entries maybe be asked to trot a fence, halt, and back up. Fence height shall not exceed 2'6". **Scores of both classes (Class # 30 & #40) will be added together to determine final placings.** In the event of a tie, a test may be asked for at the discretion of the judge. **Cooler and eight ribbons will be awarded with prize moneys shown.**

CLASS DEFINITIONS

- A. BABY GREEN** - Open to any horse in their first or second year of showing who has never shown higher than 2'6" in said 1st or 2nd year. Horses that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence heights exceed 2'6". No rider restrictions.
- B. LOW HUNTER** - Open to all horses and ponies with no age limitations. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences not to exceed 2'6".
- C. CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY** - Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. Small ponies, 12.2 hands and under to jump 2'. Medium ponies, 12.2 but not exceeding 13.2 to jump 2'3". Large ponies, over 13.2 but not to exceed 14.2 to jump 2'6". Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. NOTE: Children's Hunter may be run together as long as riders designate horse or pony.
- D. CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE** - Open to horses to be shown by junior riders. Riders over 15 years of age must still be eligible for Limit equitation over fences (i.e., they have not won 6 equitation blues over fences) as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 3' for horses. Note: if 6 or more of each (horses and ponies) are entered in this class, it should be split. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.
- E. OPEN WORKING / JUNIOR HUNTER** - Fences to be 3' to 3'3". No restrictions on age or status of rider except in Junior Hunter. Judged on manners, suitability and soundness.
- F. ADULT HUNTER DIVISION** - Open to horses ridden by riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 3'. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.
- G. PLEASURE DIVISION** - May include Open Pleasure, Road Hack, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Pleasure. Classes must be open to all horses and ponies. To be shown on the flat only at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Martingales not permitted.
- H. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION** - Fences not to exceed 18" in height. Open to riders 12 and under and not eligible to show in any other division except for the Pleasure or classes where fence height does not exceed 18".
- I. LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION** - Fences not to exceed 18" in height. Open to riders 13 and over who have never competed in any classes where the fence height exceeds 2'. Riders may not show in any division other than Pleasure and classes where fence height does not exceed 2'.
- J. PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION** - Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3 in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'0. No combinations. This division is limited to riders 14 years of age and younger.
- K. CHILDREN'S EQUITATION** - Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6 in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'6 with at least one change of direction. No combinations.
- L. MODIFIED JUNIOR EQUITATION** - Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 3' in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'9 with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional.

ENTRY AGREEMENT, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK
I agree to abide by the rules of this competition as set forth by the management of this show. I understand that the show management has the right to modify, change, cancel, combine classes and class specifications, over rule, and/or make judgments over any discrepancies or issues that may arise during the competition. I agree to allow show management the use of my photos taken at this competition to be used in results articles, promotional flyers, and etc.

Under Massachusetts Law, Section 2D of Chapter 128 of the General Laws, "no participant or participants representative shall make any claim against, maintain as action against, or recover from an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional or any other person for injury loss, damage, or death of the participant resulting from any of the inherent risks of equine activities.

I understand that EQUINE ACTIVITIES are potentially dangerous, and that I may be injured and/or lose or damage personal property as a result of participation in the program, lesson and/or competition. Therefore, I ASSUME ALL RISKS RELATED TO THE ACTIVITIES including, but not limited to: bodily injury of any nature whether severe or not, including but not limited to head trauma, joint trauma, broken bones, oral, eye or other facial injury, other muscular-skeletal injury which may be temporary or permanent, including death, which may occur as a result of riding horses, contact with horses or equipment, physical surrounding or other rider and horses. I understand that injuries such as fractures, joint/muscle sprains and dislocations, and contusions are commonplace in sports.

Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute and agreement and affirmation that the person making it, along with owner, leasee, trainer, manager, agent coach, driver, rider and the horse, (1) shall be subject to the constitution and local rules of the show; (2) that every horse, rider and or driver is eligible as entered; (3) that the owner and any of his representatives show are bound by the constitution and rules of the show and will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, Blythwood Stables, their officials, directors, and employees and volunteers harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in conjunction with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions or said officials, directors, employees or agent of the show.

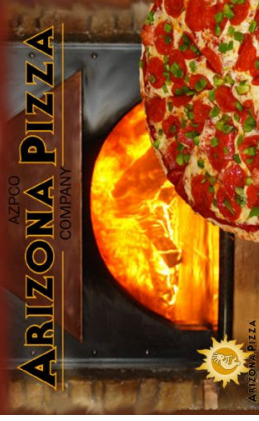
